Trash Pickup Reminders

Please put your trash in a secured container before setting it out for pickup to reduce the chances of it being dispersed by animals. Containers must be no larger than 32 gallons in size and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Help protect trash collectors by not putting dangerous liquids or sharp objects in your trash. Broken glass or broken porcelain pieces should be properly secured and not left loose in personal containers or in bags. Do not overfill individual containers or bags and please double bag pet waste.

Trash pickup: Aug. 7, 14, 21 & 28

Recycling pickup: Aug. 14 & 28

Next Large Item Removal: Oct. 2

Set your large items out with your trash for pickup by 7AM on the day listed above.

Remember, trash pickup will be on Thursday the week of Labor Day!
