E-waste Banned from Disposal in Colorado Landfills in 2013

Effective, July 1, 2013, in accordance with Colorado's Electronic Recycling Jobs Act (SB 12-133, 4/20/12) which bans the disposal of electronic waste in Colorado landfills, **the City can no longer accept electronic devices in the trash.**
